

NAiMA Pullover DK notes- mark off as you finish rows

abbreviations:

**BOR** = beginning of round marker

**kds or pds** = knit or purl double stitch like k2tog, except through both legs of the double stitch

**k2tog** = knit the next 2 stitches on the L needle together as one by putting the R needle thru fronts of both stitches from left to right, wrapping and pulling the new stitch through both

**mds** = make double stitch, with working yarn in front, slip the next stitch onto the R needle purlwise. pull up on working yarn to stretch the base of the slipped stitch and lay yarn over the R needle. Bring front between needles if the next stitch is a purl, otherwise knit normally.

**SM**=slip marker, I assume that you will do this and have indicated marker placement in the notes with a [ or]

**ssk** = slip next stitch *knitwise*, repeat. Put the L needle tip into the fronts of the 2 slipped stitches, wrap the yarn around the R needle and pull the new loop through

**st** = stitches

**YO**= yarn over, bring yarn between needles from back to front and lay over the R. needle to create a stitch

## COLLAR

Cast on for your size in your preferred cast on

Immediately place different colored markers to track BOR-Left sleeve-Back-Right Sleeve-Front

Eyelets (YOs) do not go inside sleeve markers, only at the beginning and end of the front or back. All Collar YOs are paired with a decrease (ssk or k2tog) so the stitch number total does

not change. Collar rounds to 3.25 inches

Rnd 19 like 3 (check length if at least 3.25" skip rnd 20-27)

Rnd 20 like 4

Rnd 21 like 1 (YO)

Rnd 22 like 2

Rnd 23 like 3 (check length if at least 3.25" skip rnd 24-27)

Rnd 24 like 4

Rnd 25 like 1 (YO)

Rnd 26 like 2

Rnd 27 like 3

STOP and Change to larger 16" needle

Rnd 28 Set up round is the last round of collar ribbing and is the same as a Rnd 4, no increases or YOs, just adding a second marker 2 stitches after each previous marker to denote the raglan stitches between the sleeves, front and back

#### YOKE

All YOs in the yoke are increases and are no longer paired with a decrease.

YOs continue to be worked in the same 4 round interval

YOs continue to be made just inside the markers for the Front and Back

#### PLEASE TRY TO WORK SHORT ROWS 1-8 IN ONE SITTING

Short rows are worked back and forth with increases in pattern. Note even rows are knit (RS) odd rows are purl (WS)

[2] = raglan marker stitches

your set up: [2] Left sleeve st [2] Back st [2] Right sleeve st [2] Front st

Row 1: [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO, k1 & turn (7 st inc)

Row 2: mds, p1 [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] YO, p1 (1 st inc)

Row 3: mds, k1 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k1, kds, k2, turn (4 st inc)

Row 4: mds, p3 [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p1, pds, p2, turn (no st inc)

Row 5: mds, k3 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO, k3, kds, k2, turn (7 st inc)

Row 6: mds, p6 [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] YO, p3, pds, p2, turn (1 st inc)

Row 7: mds, k6 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k6, kds, k2, turn (4 st inc)

Row 8: mds, p8 [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p→ [2] p6, pds, p2, turn (no st inc)

partial Row 9: mds, k8 to BOR,

STOP and check the stitch counts in each section against the pattern before continuing  
Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Yoke increases after short rows, please note that stitche counts are given throughout the pattern for each row. you are responsible for checking that you are staying on track.

Rnd 1: [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO (8 st inc)

Rnd 2 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k →> (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→> (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k →> (no st inc)

*Radial increase round 5: STOP and SEE PATTERN for your size for X and Y*

Rnd 5 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, kX-1, YO (many st inc, see pattern)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Rnd 2 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

The next four rounds are repeated 4 times for size 1-4 and 3 more times for size 5-9 (omit rnds 22-24 for size 5-9)

Rnd 1: [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO k—> YO [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO k—> YO (8 st inc)

Rnd 2 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

*Radial increase round 6: STOP and SEE PATTERN for your size for X and Y*

[2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, kX, YO [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, kX, YO (many st inc, see pattern)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Rnd 2 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

The next four rounds are repeated 1 times for size 1, 2 times for size 2-4, and 3 more times for size 5-9 (omit rnds as needed for your size)

Rnd 1: [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO k—> YO [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] YO k—> YO (8 st inc)

Rnd 2 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> [2] m1L k—> m1R [2] k—> (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k—> [2] k —> (no st inc)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Sizes 1-4 skip ahead to next All Sizes section

Sizes 5-9

*Radial increase round 7: STOP and SEE PATTERN for your size for X and Y*

[2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, kX, YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO (kX, m1L) Y times, kX, YO (many st inc, see pattern)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Rnd 2 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k → (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k → (no st inc)

Size 5, 6, 7 go on to next All Sizes section

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

Size 8 repeat rows 1-4 1, size 9 repeats 1-4 2 more times

Rnd 1: [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] YO k→ YO (8 st inc)

Rnd 2 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k → (no st inc)

Rnd 3 [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ [2] m1L k→ m1R [2] k→ (4 st inc)

Rnd 4 [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k→ [2] k → (no st inc)

Fill in for your size: Sleeve stitches\_\_\_\_\_ F or B sts\_\_\_\_\_ (not including the 4 sets of raglan stitches)

All Sizes

Moving the increases and the markers

Rnd 1 move&inc rnd:

(Left sleeve)

k to marker, remove marker (rm), k1, place marker (pm), m1L knit to 1 st before marker, m1R, pm, k1, rm, knit to marker, rm, k1, pm,

(Front)

YO, knit to 1 st before marker, YO, pm,

(Right Sleeve)

k1, rm, k to marker, rm, k1, pm, m1L knit to 1 st before marker, m1R, pm, k1, rm, k to marker, rm, k1, pm,

(Back)

YO, knit to 1 st before marker, YO, place new BORm, k1, remove old BOR

Rnd 2 knit all, slipping markers as you come to them

Rnd 3 knit all, slipping markers as you come to them

Rnd 4 knit all, slipping markers as you come to them

Repeat 1-4 2(1, 1, 0, 2)(2, 2, 1, 0) more times SEE PATTERN
